SA Book Awards 2024 Shortlist Announced

This year marks the 24th annual SA Book Awards, powered by Nielsen BookData and supported by PASA and SABA. The awards strive to celebrate books written and published in South Africa, as voted for by South African booksellers and last year recognised authors Sally Andrew, Louisa Holst and Riaan Manser.

The awards celebrate South African booksellers' favourite titles in three categories: Fiction, Non-Fiction and Children's. This year the shortlists have been curated by a highly respected panel from the South Africa book industry.

The panel reviewed a longlist of bestselling titles, as measured by Nielsen BookScan South Africa, to generate each shortlist. Each title had to be written by a South African author and published in South Africa between 1 January 2023 to 31 December 2023.

South African booksellers have now been invited to vote for their favourite shortlisted title from each of the categories to decide the winners. Each category winner will be awarded R5,000.00 and the overall winner, receiving the highest number of votes, will be presented with R20,000.00. The winners will be announced at a virtual ceremony and on social media on Wednesday 18 December 2024.

On accepting his award in 2023, Riaan Manser who was on board a plane at the time said: "President Nelson Mandela once told me my bicycle ride around Africa would inspire the youth of the continent.
